- 1. Meeting called to order by president at 6:03pm.
- 2. Review of 2022 Year End Financials
  - a. Profitable despite thinking we would be in the red due to increased expenses.
  - b. Questions from Jordan.
    - i. Why is income for December higher than November?
    - ii. Is MMM in "site expenses"?
    - iii. Accounting services is 0, is Lyndee covering that now?
- Bank Balances
  - a. Years' worth of expenses in the bank incase of emergency.
    - i. This justification for having \$58,000 in the bank is valid.
      - 1. i.e. in an economic disaster, the market wouldn't charge booth fees and savings would be able to cover costs for that year.
- 4. Proposed Budget for 2023
  - a. Existing numbers rounded up and adjusted for 2023
  - b. With exception of merchandise
    - i. Adding hats. Anna also has great ideas for new shirts. And maybe silicone pint cups/water bottles.
  - c. If adding merch, add \$1000 to the Cost of Goods Sold.
